A BRIEF HISTORY OF ST. BONAVENTURE'S COLLEGE

St. Bonaventure's College was opened in 1856 by Bishop Mullock under the leadership of the Franciscans. In 1889, the administrative role was taken over by the Christian Brothers. Under the Christian Brothers, the College flourished both in academics and athletics. In 1962, St. Bon's changed from a K-11 school, to a K-8 with the re-organization of the Catholic schools in the city. After 99 years of leadership, the Christian Brothers withdrew from the College in 1988 and the school came under lay leadership. In 1998, denominational education ended in Newfoundland and with the reorganization of the schools, St. Bon's was closed. Supported by the Society of Jesus, a group of parents and benefactors came together, and St. Bonaventure's College re-opened in 1999 and is today the only independent, Catholic, K-12 School in the province.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



The 2014-2015 school year was marked by a number of exciting initiatives and achievements.

- Herculean efforts saw hugely successful fundraisers held including the Walk-a-thon, Fall Gala and Lottery.
- The 2nd Annual Ignatian Spirit Award Tribute Dinner was held and honoured Dr. Michael Bautista.
- The 2nd Annual St. Bon’s Cup Golf Tournament saw an increase in net revenue by 60% over the first year.
- The Ignatius Society held its 2nd Annual Ignatius Society Dinner hosted by His Grace, Archbishop Currie, in the Archdiocesan Library. Membership increased from 19 members to 27 members this past year.
- The SBC Endowment Fund received a significant donation of \$50,000 from an anonymous donor.
- We instituted our first Giving Tuesday initiative using text messaging. Ninety-three donors gave \$1,100 for the primary reading program.
- During the school year our students raised money for a number of charities including the Loyola Secondary School in Wau South Sudan, Canadian Jesuits International, Emmaus House, Broken Earth, and Ronald McDonald House.
- Our total donations and fundraising efforts raised \$405,751.90

Please take a moment to review the results of the fundraising efforts in the past year. Each and every donation, no matter the method, is greatly appreciated.

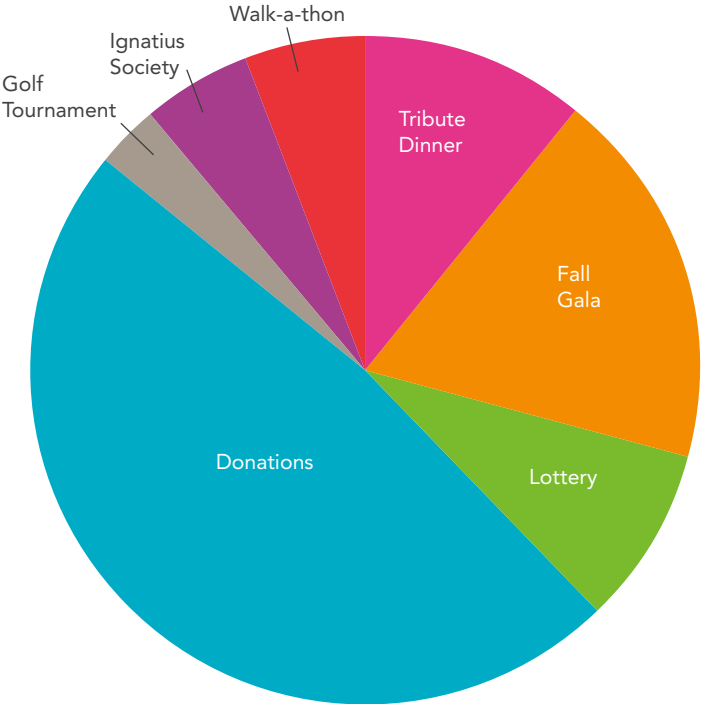

Bursary Program

To ensure no child is unable to attend St. Bonaventure's College because of the inability to pay, the Bursary Program provides financial assistance towards tuition.

This program is vital to the school's mission of educating students of diverse backgrounds. Funds for this program come from several sources including directed donations, the Ignatius Society, memorial donations, the Tribute Dinner, and the Brother Brennan Endowment Fund.

Thanks to supporters like you, over \$163,000 was offered to bursary applicants in 2015. Currently 1 in 11 students receives a form of tuition assistance.

Endowment Fund

An endowment fund is a permanent self-sustaining source of funding. St. Bonaventure's College Endowment Fund's assets are invested and portions of the earned income provides annual support for the bursary program.

Charitable Giving

Gifts for Current Programs

Donations are accepted on an ongoing basis for various program as directed by donors. These areas included but are not limited to Academics, Athletics, Chapel, Campus Ministry, Drama, Facilities and Music.

Types of gifts accepted are:

A Gift of Cash, most often in the form of a cheque made payable to St. Bonaventure's College or by credit/debit card.

Annual Giving

By giving annually to St. Bon's, our alumni, parents, faculty and friends support the programs and activities that enrich the experiences of our students. Donations to the Annual Giving campaign provides equipment, infrastructure, and opportunities beyond those afforded by tuition to support the academic excellence of our students. Annual gifts can be set up for automatic withdrawal from your checking account monthly, quarterly, or annually.

Gifts Planned for the Future

Bequest: This is a gift made by provision in one's will naming St. Bonaventure's College as a beneficiary. It can reduce estate taxes.

Charitable Gift Annuity: This gift allows the donor to receive benefits for his/her lifetime and to receive charitable tax deduction.

Charitable Remainder Trust: This form of support transfers assets to a trustee, who in turn manages the trust and pays an income back to the donor for life or a specific time. When the trust terminates the remainder is passes to St. Bonaventure's College.

Life Insurance: If St. Bonaventure's College is named the owner and beneficiary of a life insurance policy, the policy premiums become eligible as a tax-deductible gift.

St. Bonaventure's College encourages speaking to a financial advisor when considering these gift options.
